Trio of Veteran Landlord Reps Join Walnut Creek-Based Firm From Newmark

A three-person retail brokerage team that had been affiliated with Newmark going back to its Cornish & Carey Commercial predecessor firm have joined the Lockehouse Retail Group in San Francisco.

Danielle Bromstead, Sandy Berry and Meghan Basso specialize in institutional-grade landlord representation and have also represented national, regional and local retail tenants throughout the Bay Area. All three were named senior vice presidents in the firm's Landlord Services division. Lockehouse and Newmark were recently selected by Sand Hill Property to market the retail, dining and entertainment components for lease at The Rise, the long-planned redevelopment of the former Vallco Town Center in Cupertino. The first phase includes a majority of the 429,000 square feet retail, restaurant and entertainment space planned in the project, which will be one of Silicon Valley's largest mixed-use developments when fully built out.

Led by President Steve Cutter, Lockehouse operates as a full-service real estate company providing tenant and landlord representation, investment sales, property management, construction management, restaurant consultation and development services. Last year, the firm launched a growth campaign to expand across western U.S. markets.

It expanded into Southern California last September with the hiring of retail broker Mike Hieshima and his team from The Shopping Center Group. The firm also added retail analyst and executive Garrick Brown as chief operating officer and director of advisory services.
